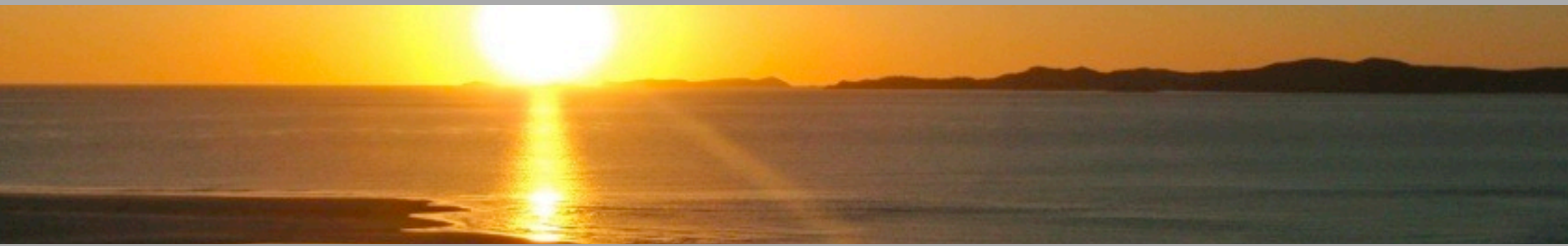

The Whitsunday Islands are comprised of 22 of the most pristine and beautiful islands in the world. They are part of the 74 islands of the Cumberland group. Within the Whitsunday group lies Whitehaven beach and Hill inlet lookout. The Whitsundays also boast many amazing snorkelling locations and protected anchorages. It is as if the area has been specially created for a sailing holiday.

They are famous for their endless landscape photo opportunities. Let the scenery pass by as the boat sails along. Take in the blue green water and lush green islands, covered in bush and pine. Feel the force of the wind as you pull the ropes. Watch out for marine life jumping out of the water. Enjoy the serenity of the stars at night.



The underwater world

The Whitsunday islands are located in the centre of the great barrier reef marine park. Within the marine park there are two basic types of reef: Fringing reef and platform reef. The outer barrier reef is mostly made up of platform reef. Within the protection of the outer reef lie the Whitsunday islands.

Amongst the Whitsunday Islands we have many sheltered bays containing fringing reef which boast beautiful coral gardens and teeming fish and marine life. The advantage of fringing coral reef for snorkelling is that they are protected by islands, meaning the snorkelling is always in calm water. The colourful corals and most abundant marine life are close to the surface, so all one needs to do is put on a mask and snorkel to be amazed by the underwater world. 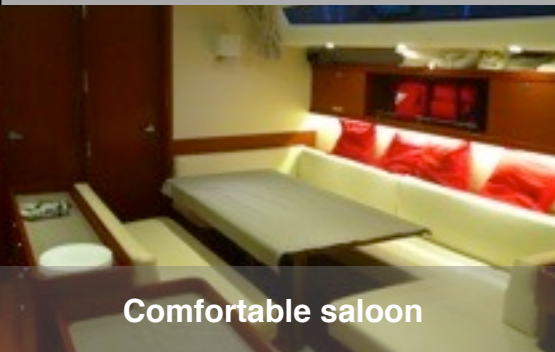

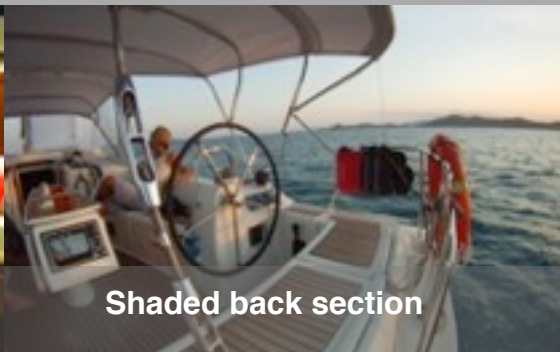

Sailing in Style

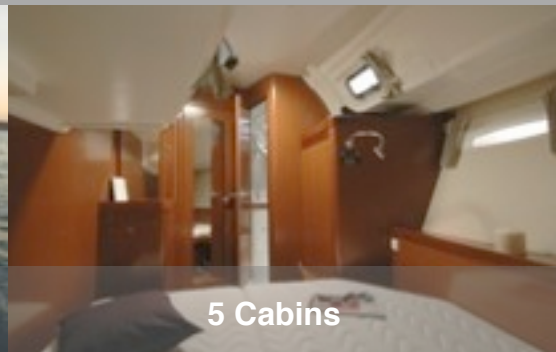

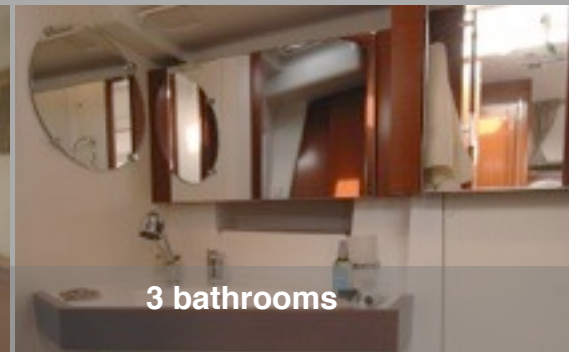
Comfortable saloon



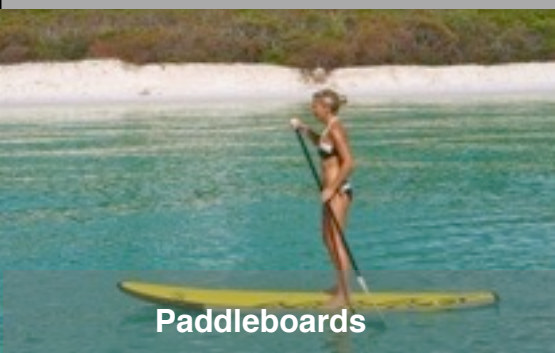
Shaded back section

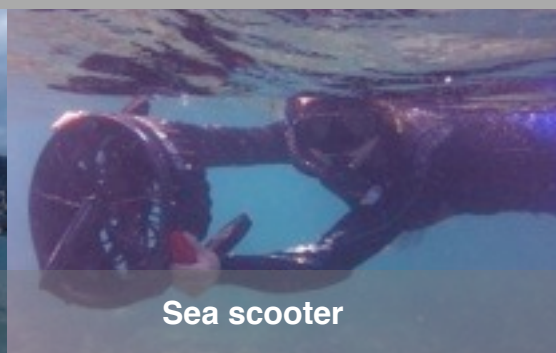

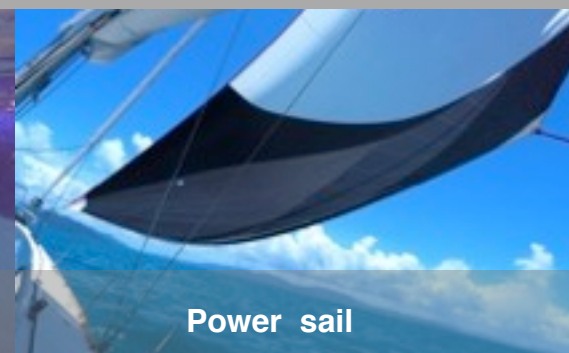

Single bunk: A single berth in a cabin, cabin will be shared with one other.

Private twin : 2 single berths in a private cabin (twin share).

Private Double: Double berth in a private cabin (twin share)

Private Double ensuite: Double berth in a private cabin with private bathroom (twin share)

Your options

2 nights over 3 days

Departs: Sunday, Tuesday or Friday. 4 pm

Returns: Tuesday, Friday or Monday 2pm

Take a fast boat, experienced crew, motivated guests and you have the recipe for experiencing more of the whitsundays than some sailors will in a week. The Highlights of a typical 2 night tour will incorporate snorkelling at two of the whitsundays best coral reefs, and a visit to the spectacular Whitehaven beach.

3 nights over 4 days

Departs: Tuesday or Thursday 4pm

Returns: Friday or Sunday 2pm

3 nights will allow you to experience all the highlights of the whitsundays islands at a relaxed pace. Your experienced captain will also show you some of his secret spots. Guest may wish to combine their adventure with a stay at Airlie Beach or Hamilton island.

5 nights over 6 days

Departs Sunday, Tuesday or Thursday . 4 pm

Longer charters allow more options and give guests the opportunity to enjoy a sleep in or a long lunch. In addition to plenty of sailing snorkelling and beaching, guests could consider a stopover at an island resort, or a hike to one of the peaks of the whitsunday islands. Action packed or totally relaxed the choice is yours.

Our vessels are very popular and the above schedules allow us to offer you the best price. Other Departures are available however additional costs will apply.

Times are based on departing/returning Abel Point Marina , Airlie Beach. We offer Hamilton island departures/returns at no extra cost. However the 3 hours it takes us to get there is deducted from the charter time.

A minimum age of 6 applies. To enjoy our experience safely guests should have a basic level of fitness and mobility(able to climb a step ladder is a good test)

Cancellation Policy:

Bookings will be confirmed on payment of deposit. Deposit is non refundable. Balance payments to be made in full 30 days before charter commencement.

Cancellations made 14 day - 30 days prior to departure will result in a forfeiture of 50% of the Balance . Cancellations made less than 14days prior will result in forfeiture of 100% of the Balance. Please note that charters are not cancelled because of weather. If the charterer wishes to cancel due to weather or for any other reason the above policy applies.

If we cancel for any reason a full refund will be provided . We will not be responsible for any losses incurred as a result of cancellation .
